

The logistics of the Chuckwalla track are always challenging, and this year proved no exception. Because of the spring event date, we had to compete with other desert events for hotel rooms and potential banquet facilities. After many efforts to find an affordable venue, Anne and the planning group came up with the idea to eat at the track while the club racers were finishing up. This kept the costs reasonable and provided a fun event for the participants. This is just one example of the many decisions that need to be made to make the event successful. All the planning in the world only goes so far. You also have to be able to improvise when necessary. On Saturday when the ambulance was not available, Kelly Moon as able to re-arrange the event on the fly to maximize available track time for drivers and racers. My highest praise is that Anne, Kelly, and the rest of the volunteers make it look easy. I assure you that it is far from easy, and I appreciate the job everybody does to make our HPDE events a success.

Normally, this would be my last discussion of track events until next year, but this year we will have *two* events. Our second HPDE will be at Buttonwillow Raceway October 28-30. We are still working on the format of the 3-day event, so stay tuned. In addition to our events, you have the unique opportunity to drive at Mazda raceway Laguna Seca during this year's Oktoberfest in August. The track will be open for HPDE for 4 days, the sound limit is 105 dB, and you can drive as many as 4 days if you and your car can handle it. If you haven't signed up for Oktoberfest yet, do it now. The hotel is filling up fast, and there are limited spots for the HPDE, Autocross and Car Control events. The registration site for all the Monterey events is https://www.bmwcca.org/celebratebmw. You can sign up for the Legends of the Autobahn Concour, Monterey Festorics and Oktoberfest all at the same site. See the ad on pages 16-17 for further information.







Rocky Mountain Chapter Autocrossing in February?

Well, sort of, but my long suffering wife Diane and I headed to San Diego for the second winter in a row to visit Club members Rick and Sharon Eismin, and coincidently it was on the same weekend as the San Diego Chapter Space Race Autocross at Qualcomm Stadium. This was indeed a striking coincidence (not), as we managed to get to San Diego for the February 2015 autocross at Qualcomm.

One of the best parts of BMW CCA membership is being able to travel the country and meet other members and participate in their local events, and the San Diego Chapter's crew are masters at putting on an autocross in the very same efficient manner as the Rocky Mountain Chapter. Very well laid out instructions, quick and thorough tech inspection, timely drivers' meeting and on-time start that allowed an incredible 8 morning practice runs and 4 afternoon timed runs. However, San Diego puts an instructor in everyone's car in the morning to make sure a complete knowledge of the course and procedures are provided.

To say the course was challenging is an understatement, and it truly utilized the huge west lot of the stadium to great advantage. The first half of the course consisted of an uphill section with 2 long sweepers, a short slalom with offset last cone and a fast downhill to the next slalom and the completely off-camber, downhill set of sweepers, slaloms and gates that ended in a tricky technical finish. The fastest car, a fully prepared Porsche GT3, ran the course in about 77 seconds while back markers with winter tires ran in the upper 90s.

Did I mention that it was an absolute blast? In our Z3, it was second gear all the way, but banging on the rev limiter a couple of times. While the course was well-marked and easy to read it had VERY technical sucker features that, while they looked easy, could add seconds to your run if you were not on top of your game. (Ask me how I know).

One difference that I liked was that 2 driver cars had the first driver doing all of their runs before turning the car over to the second driver. This really helped keep the event moving and allowed the 8 morning practice runs. However in our mud/snow-tired Z₃, it was impossible to keep the tires cool in the beautiful low 70s San Diego weather. Oh well, we run for fun and not glory.

As is normal in BMW Club events, everyone was super friendly, the lunch was great and smiles and laughs were evident all day. With luck, we will be back next February to once again destroy a set of tires and enjoy the hospitality of the San Diego Chapter.

It's time again for everyone's favorite event--our annual Runoff Autocross! This is our ninth runoff event that honors the memory of Rug Cunningham, founder of Cunningham BMW, now BMW of El Cajon.

Eleven drivers will qualify for our 2016 Runoff by winning their car classes. The winner of the Runoff will get his or her name on the perpetual trophy and will receive a personal trophy to display proudly and commemorate the event. Our format includes one practice session for all drivers, followed by three timed runs to determine trophies for this event. The first-place winner of each car class earns a runoff position in the afternoon. As all other drivers continue to enjoy fun runs in the afternoon, each runoff contender will drive the same "mystery" car. The driver with the best time will be crowned our 2016 Runoff Champion. Will it be you? Join us on Saturday, June 18 in Qualcomm's Southeast Lot to find out!

We are updating our helmet ratings to Snell 2010 or 2015. If you have Snell 2005, get your new helmet soon as our grace period ends Dec 31, 2016!

Please note: We have new car classifications as shown at right. Please make sure that your car class is up to date in Motorsport Reg, and if you have questions, feel free to email us at autocross-director@sdbmwcca.com.

Remember the sound limit at Qualcomm: all cars must be under a 92db noise level – we'll be checking!

Our sincerest thanks to BMW of El Cajon for their continued support of our Autocross Program!

Newcomers: We've all had a first time and we're all still learning, so relax, have fun, and enjoy your time with us. You will have an instructor take you around the course for one lap in your car showing you turn-in points, braking zones and so on. Your instructor will then ride with you for your next three laps helping you learn the course. In your next session, and the timed runs, you can have an instructor with you as much or as little as you want – whatever makes you comfortable. These events are what you make them; you can push for good lap times and enjoy the friendly competition or you can have more of a social event where running laps is just another part of a fun-filled day.

See the **Autocross Information Page** at http://www.sdbmwcca.com/autocross to get a better idea of how to prepare for this wonderfully addictive sport for your first time.

Note: We do run if it's raining – you'll learn more and your tires will wear less – so if you see some unusual drops of water falling from the sky, grab your raingear and head to the Q! Also, the helmet standard has changed to require Snell 2005 or 2010 ratings. Check yours now to be sure it's up to date – rentals are limited.

The entry fee is \$65, including breakfast items, lunch, and beverages. You can pay online if you register in advance at http://sdbmwcca.motorsportreg.com, or with cash or check if you wait to register onsite. You must be a BMW CCA member to participate, and you can join online at www.bmwcca.org in advance. Please **print and bring your membership confirmation** if you have not yet received your BMW CCA membership card. We check membership of all participants at the gate.

REMEMBER: IF REGISTERED ONLINE, **BRING PROOF OF MEMBERSHIP** AND ARRIVE BY 7:30AM (BEFORE ON-SITE CUT-OFF) TO KEEP YOUR RESERVED SPOT

Gates will open at 6:30am; tech and registration will open at 7:00am. Tech will close at 8:20am and no cars will be inspected or allowed to run after this time. There is a **mandatory drivers meeting at 8:30am** and the course opens for runs at 9:00am.

When you arrive:

- 1. If you registered online, stop at the gate to sign the waiver and notify the Gate Greeter. Your name will be checked off the pre-registration list. All participants must show their BMW CCA membership card. Those who did not register online will receive a numbered card at the gate in their order of arrival; take it to the Registration table. There is no guarantee that spots will be available for those who wait to register the day of the event.
- 2. Empty all loose items from your car, then go through the Tech Line and have your car inspected. Bring your Tech card and you will receive Tech and helmet stickers.
- 3. Take Gate card and Tech card to Registration to get checked off for pre-registration or pay your \$65 entry fee. You will receive car numbers to place on your side windows.
- 4. If you don't have a helmet, you can rent one from the club for \$10.
- 5. Your entry fee of \$65.00 includes one lunch and unlimited beverages. Additional lunches can be purchased at Registration for \$7 each.

Women drivers and Novices are classified based upon the car they are driving. We award a Women's Class trophy to the woman with the fastest time, and two Novice trophies to the two fastest novices. This means women and novices will be eligible for multiple trophies. You are only a novice for the first and second time you autocross, and if you win a novice or class trophy you are no longer a novice.

- NAM ALL naturally aspiriated, non-M BMWs not in Legacy Class Modified
- TS ALL turbocharged BMWs (4-6-8-12 cyl, gas or diesel)
 Stock
- **TM** ALL turbocharged BMWs (4-6-8-12 cyl, gas or diesel) Modified
- MS ALL M cars under 400 factory hp Stock

- ANY air filter or air intake AHEAD OF mass airflow meter
- Non-stock software/firmware is permitted on naturally-aspirated engines only
- ANY brake pad material is allowed with Stock-size brake components
- Catalyst-back exhaust systems and strut tower braces are permitted

ANY other alterations move to Modified Classes, including:

- Tires with DOT treadwear rating under 140
- Non-stock springs, coilover suspensions, nonstock anti-roll bars
- Software/firmware alterations to turbocharged/ supercharged engines
- Non-stock mass airflow meters, camshafts, downpipes, removed catalytic converter
- Non-stock-size brake rotors or calipers (stock-size replacements OK in Stock)




